

In Season 9, Episode 4 of *Discovery Mountain*, dinosaur expert Rich talked about slime! Now you can create your very own slime, too. Ask an adult for permission first, and have fun creating.



Slime Recipe

- 1 4-ounce bottle of liquid white school glue
- 1/4 cup water
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 drop of food coloring (any color—you choose)
- 1 tablespoon contact solution*

Wash hands and find a washable surface to work on, as this recipe can get messy!

Squeeze the glue from the bottle into a large bowl. With a mixing spoon, stir in the water and the baking soda. With an adult's help, carefully add a drop or two of food coloring. Mix well. Add the contact solution and stir to combine.

Pour out the slime onto a clean surface and knead with your hands. If the slime feels too sticky, add 1 teaspoon of contact solution. Knead thoroughly. Wash up your working surface and tools and enjoy your slime!

*Any saline solution or contact solution will work as long as it contains boric acid and sodium borate.
