- 1) What king came to Jerusalem and besieged it?
- 2) Who did the king put in charge of some young Israelite men for teaching?
- 3) What were Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah's Babylonian names?
- 4) What would Daniel and his three friends not do that the chief of the eunuchs asked them to do?
- 5) Daniel asked the chief eunuch to test them for ten days. What were the physical results of being faithful to God?
- 6) What gifts did God give these four young men?
- 7) When Nebuchadnezzar examined them, what did he discover about these four men?
- 8) How did Daniel explain his ability to interpret Nebuchadnezzar's dream?

## CHALLENGE:

What king was tricked into signing a decree that whoever worshiped a god or man other than him for thirty days would be thrown into the lions' den?



(1) Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, (2) Ashpenaz, (3) Daniel became Belteshazzar, Hananiah became Shadrach, Mishael became Meshach, and Azariah became Abed-Nego, (4) They would not defile themselves with the king's rich food and wine, (5) They looked better and healthier than all the young men who had eaten the king's food, (6) God gave them knowledge and skill in all literature and wisdom, and Daniel understood visions and dreams, (7) He found them to be ten times wiser than all the magicians and astrologers of his realm, (8) Daniel credited it all to God, who had chosen to reveal the dream's secret to him, (9) CHALLENGE: King Darius
